

7 Days-5 Spots, includes the combination of two activities that most excite us: surfing and sailing.

For a week, the sailing ship becomes your house and a way of transport to access the waves from the sea, away from the crowds and the overcrowded beaches.

Some of the most popular waves of the Basque Coast are; the spot of Mundaka, Omain Zumaia, Zarautz and the spot of Zurriola in San Sebastian. Obviously, there are many more!

The route that we propose would consist of:

Day 1-2: Spot of Mundaka (night in Bermeo)

Mundaka is located in one of the most spectacular landscapes of the Basque Coast; Urdaibai, declared a biosphere reserve in the estuary of Gernika. After surfing in Mundaka, we will sail to Bermeo, a traditional fishing town, to spend the first night.

Day 3-4: Spot of Orrua (night in Zumaia)

The next day, we set sail heading Zumaia to surf in Orrua, a small rocky bay at the mouth of the UrolaRiver near the village of Zumaia.

Day 5: Spot of Itzurun (night in Zumaia)

Having rested in Zumaia, we will take the opportunity to visit one of the most interesting treasures of the Basque Coast: the Flysch. We will have access to the wave of the beach of Itzurun.

Day 6: Spot ofZarautz (night in Getaria)

We will sail from Zumaia toZarautz where you will be able to jump into water to surf the waves of the beach of Zarautz famous for being one of the longest in the Bay of Biscay. Surfing is the sport by excellence of the city. That night we will sleep in the beautiful port of Getaria.

Day 7: Spot of Zurriola (night in San Sebastian)

The last day we will sail to San Sebastian to surf in Zurriola and enjoy a cultural evening in the city of San Sebastian.
